Club Director - Roles and Responsibilities

The Club Director position is a role that comes with the responsibility of guiding the strategic direction of the Club.

The Club Director's primary role is to vote on matters at Board level to support and inform the strategic direction of the Club.

Some of the roles of the Club Director are listed below. Noting that these roles need not be performed by the Club Director in isolation, but can be delegated to others as required, this list will change as the Club and needs grow.

Roles of the Club Director:

- Vote for one of the Club Directors to be named as Managing Director
- Attend, contribute meaningfully and vote at Board meetings
- Ensure proper conduct regarding Club Constitution
- Undertake Club Director orientation when voted to the Board
- Contribute to the content of the Club annual report
- Provide other Directors with the opportunity to be heard
- Support and promote the Club direction to Club members

Failure to perform these roles adequately may render the Club Director liable for suspension from the Board for a period of time.
