Working With Vulnerable People (WWVP) Policy

Gungahlin Cats are committed to the safety of our members and participants in our sport.

Gungahlin Cats will aim to ensure that all Gungahlin Cats volunteers assisting with Touch Football operations at Amaroo hold a valid Working with Vulnerable People (WWVP) accreditation.

Directors of the Club will be asked to gain this accreditation within 3 months of joining the Board.

Gungahlin Cats members who assist at the fields will be asked to undertake this check and provide confirmation to the Club.

Where there is competition for a position as a volunteer, preference will be given to those persons who hold this accreditation.
