Safe Play and Training Policy

Gungahlin Cats are committed to the safety of our participants.

Hire of Grounds:

Gungahlin Cats and Ninja Cats teams will play only in competitions that have appropriate insurance coverage provided by Touch Football Australia or an affiliated partner. Such competitions include but are not limited to:

- Local ACT-based Domestic competitions,
- TFACT Premier League,
- TFACT Super League,
- Yass Knockout and,
- Cootamundra Knockout

Ninja Cats and Gungahlin Cats social-game activities (State of Origin, MusterDays, training etc) shall be run on appropriately hired grounds.

Gungahlin Cats training sessions will be organised and run on appropriately hired grounds.

In the event of training times changing or being rescheduled, coaches are to notify and negotiate with the managing director on these changes giving a minimum of (5) business days' notice. There are limited funds budgeted by the board for hiring fields and all parties need to be aware that these funds are to be spent efficiently. Preferably elite teams training sessions are to be run at the same time on the same fields to make full use of the money spent on hiring the fields. The board and club will not be liable for coaches or players running unsanctioned training sessions on fields that have not been hired.

Training Limitations:

In the instance of extreme heat or cold, coaches of Gungahlin Cats teams will have regard for the safety of the players and adapt training methods, including water breaks, to suit the conditions.
