Uniform Policy

The Gungahlin Cats operate a system where each Active Member of the Club is granted an individual and unique playing number when they join the organisation.

This number corresponds with the number worn on the back of the member's playing shirt/singlet for competition, and remains their playing number until they cease membership with the Club.

After this period, the Club may decide to re-issue the playing number to another member.

Non-Playing (Supporting) Membership

Membership of the Club is not restricted to playing members, with multiple types of membership available. Active Members that transition to Supporting Members will maintain their number until they are no longer a member of the Club, so long as they maintain membership with the Club.

Please note that under our Constitution, Supporting Members do not have voting rights at the AGM.

Retirement of Numbers

If a member has provided service of such significance that they have been awarded Life Membership of the club, the member's playing number shall be retired from domestic competition.

Should this honour be bestowed on a member, the ruling will last in perpetuity (non-rescindable), in the same manner as life membership.
